AMENDMENT TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS / NOTICE OF RACE

OVERVIEW

The following amendments have been made to the original Sailing Instructions (SIs) and/or Notice of Race (NoR) issued to competitors and published. These amendments are included in SIs denoted "BTR 2022 Sailing Instructions Final 1a" which is also published online at www.bangortownregatta.com

AMENDMENTS to SIs

1. SI 9.6 states "Courses for the coastal races may also be announced on VHF. Failure to do so or failure to hear this transmission will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1." and has been restated as follows: "Courses for the coastal races may also be announced on VHF. VHF channels for each race area will be given at the briefing. Failure to do so or failure to hear any transmission will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1."
2. SI Addendum C Coastal Races describes Mark A and M (same mark) as a "Red Inflatable marked 10". It is now described as "Black buoy marked 11". Other details are unchanged.

AMENDMENTS to NoRs

1. NoR 4.3 states "Boats in Classes 1 to 6, 9 and 10 shall display a class pennant, appropriate to the class in which she is sailing, from their backstay at all times when racing". This is amended to state "Boats in Classes 1 to 5, 8 and 10 shall display a class pennant, appropriate to the class in which she is sailing, from their backstay at all times when racing".
